



## 2019 VECF DATA INITIATIVE PROJECT LIST

<b>Southwest</b>	Develop data-sharing agreements with school divisions and Head Start providers in four localities.
<b>Roanoke</b>	In partnership with the Roanoke Valley Regional Commission, complete two mapping projects: a Fiscal Map and a Resource Map.
<b>Fairfax</b>	Expand/enhance their Early Childhood Data Dashboard.
<b>Central Virginia</b>	Enhance data system to incorporate two new domains: early education experience of entering kindergarteners; and CLASS data to make these easily accessible and useful to classroom teachers.
<b>Danville Pittsylvania</b>	Develop a Data Capacity Action Plan. Customize Tableau to incorporate locally-desired data elements.
<b>Rappahannock Area</b>	Increase data capacity by adding new data elements via the Toolkit and other sources; incorporate in Tableau and display on website.
<b>Eastern Shore</b>	Develop a Data Capacity Action Plan. Complete a Fiscal Map project for both Eastern Shore counties.
<b>Western Tidewater</b>	Develop a Data Capacity Action Plan. Begin development of IT infrastructure and content needed for an effective early childhood data system.
<b>New River Valley</b>	In partnership with New River Valley Regional Commission and Smart Beginnings Southwest Virginia, pilot a data system component to collect and manage regional early childhood workforce data.
<b>Greater Richmond</b>	Develop process and tools to measure early education experiences of entering kindergarteners; measure “family engagement” practices of community partners.
